VINO DE PARCELAS – CAÑA-ANDREA:

Manda Huevos – Vulgarismo originario de la voz latina Mandat Opus, precursora de la expresión manda oebos. En su forma original significa la necesidad obliga.

Nowadays a vulgarism in Spanish borne out of frustration meaning “I can’t believe it”, “get out of here”, etc , but actually originating from the latin *Mandat Opus* meaning you are obliged to do something out of necessity.

Our vineyards are within the commune of Villarroya in Calatayud but we felt obliged by necessity to make these wines outside of the Denominación de Origen.

1ª EDICION PARCELAS CAÑA-ANDREA:

Uvas tintas de dos parcelas con el mismo nombre. Una plantada en 1908 justo después de filoxera es una mezcla de Garnacha Fina, Garnacha Blanca, Moristel y Bobal. La otra plantada en 1970 es 100% Garnacha Fina.

Fermentación en tinajas abiertas, sin bombear, solamente bazuqueo. Dies meses de crianza sobre lías en huevos de 900 litros antes embotellar.

1st EDICION SINGLE VINEYARD PARCELS CAÑA-ANDREA:

Old vine red from two parcels with the same name with an extensión of 1,5 ha between both parcels. The upper part was planted in 1908 and contains a pot pourri of varieties with around 85% Garnacha Tinta Fina and the remainder being a mix of Garnacha Blanca, Moristel and Bobal (known locally as Provechon). The lower part was planted in 1970 and is 100% Garnacha Tinta Fina.
